



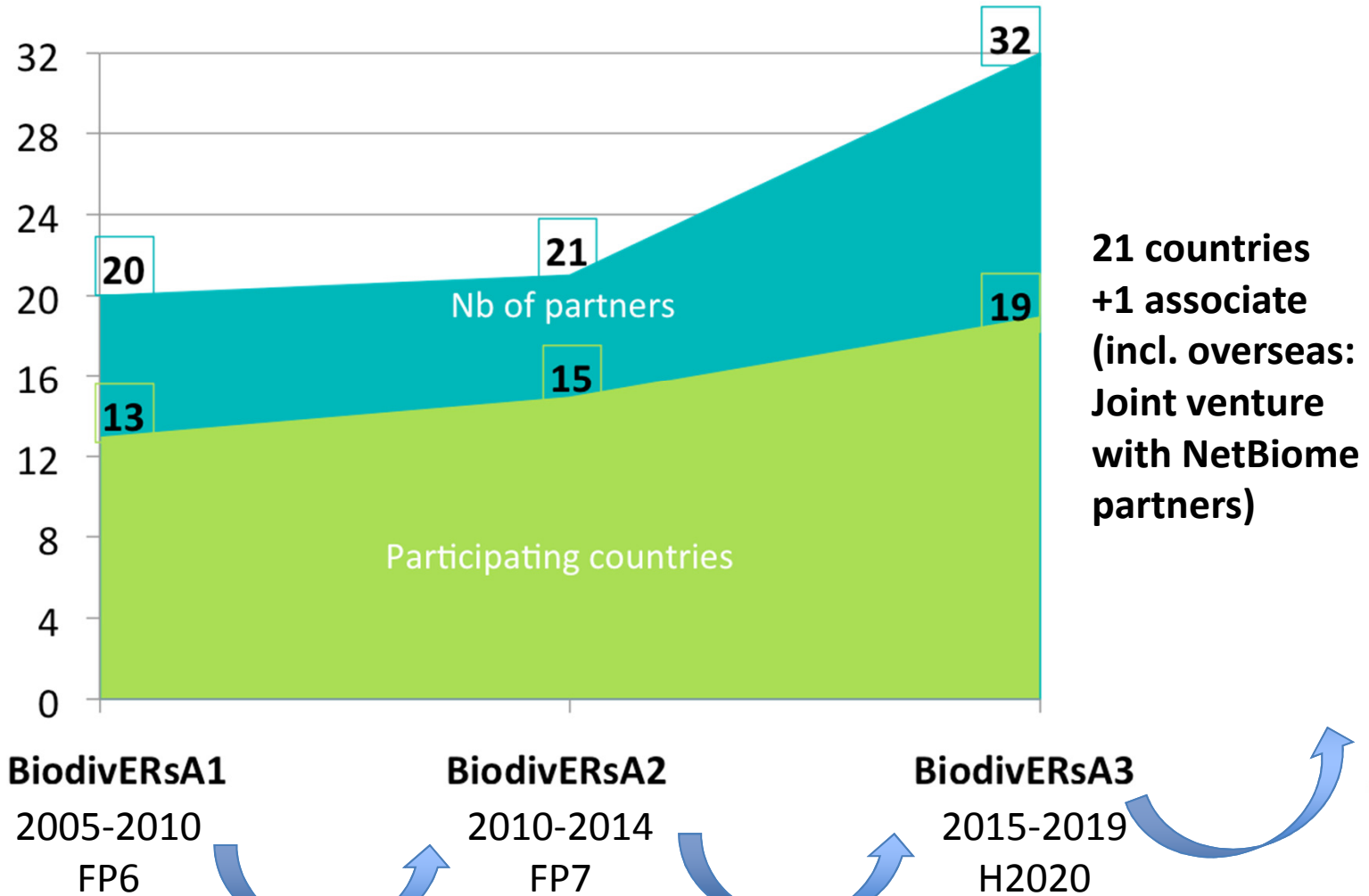

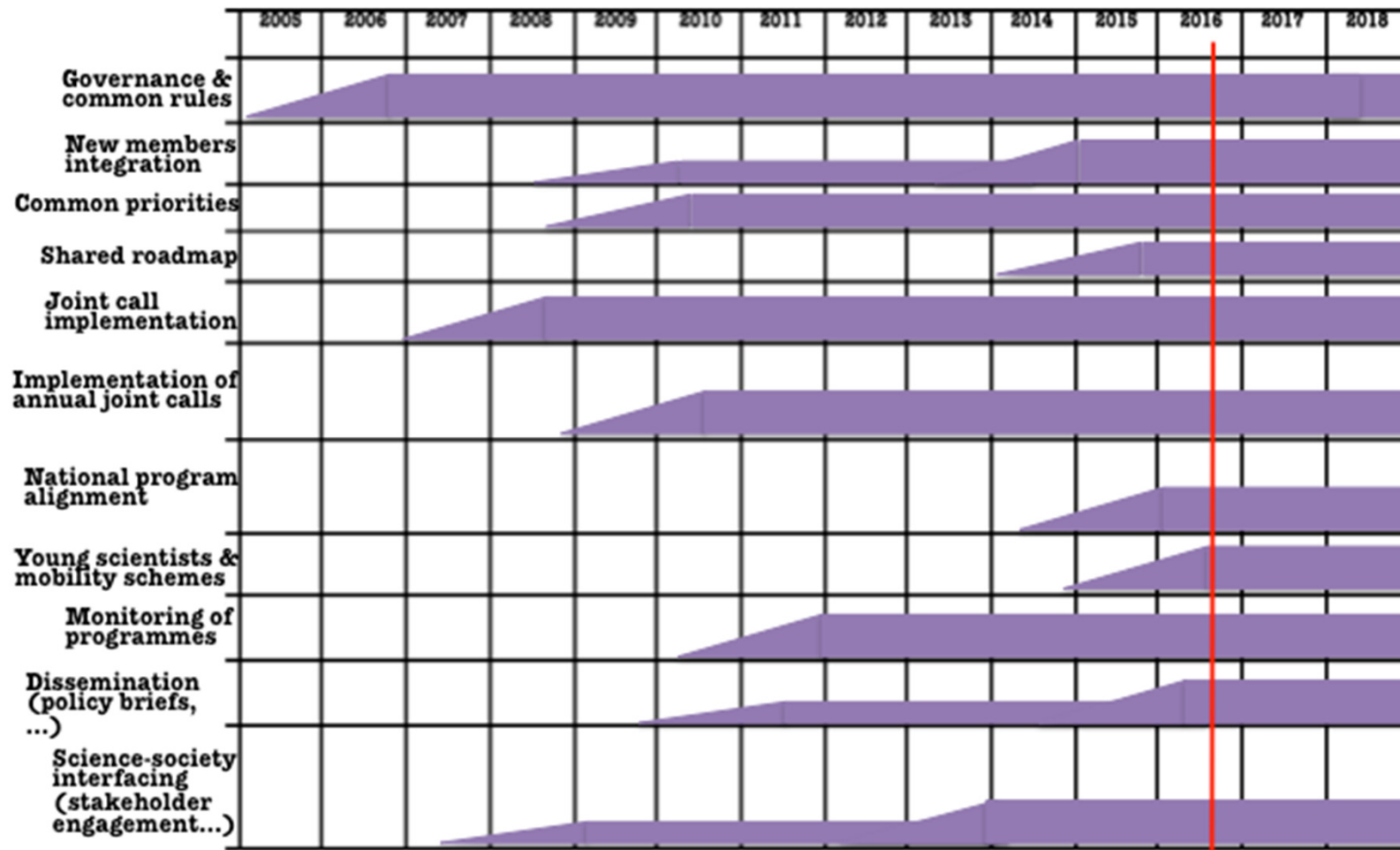


Enduring connectivity: Enlargement to build the ERA





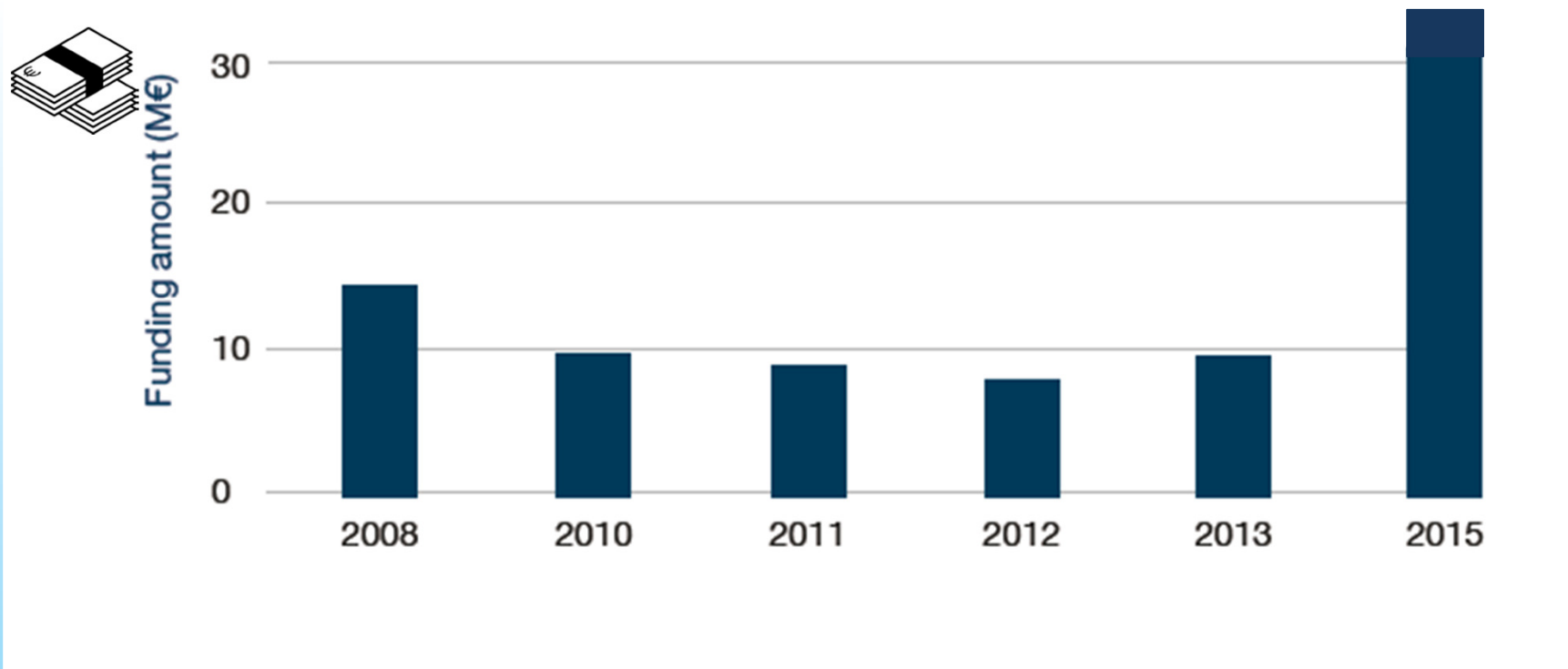
Enduring connectivity: Addressing a range of issues key to Joint Programming





Capacity building → Efficiency of a large and diverse network

Ex. of efficiency: ambitious joint calls - 19 countries participating
Total: 80 M€ in cash – 134 M€ in total

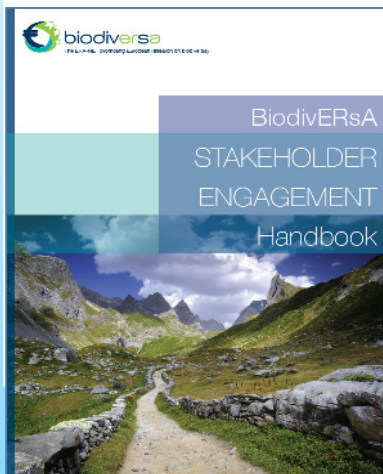

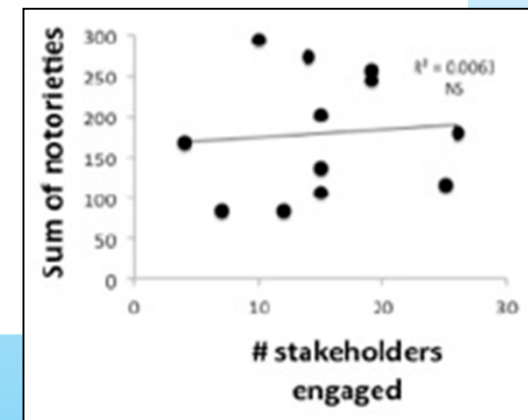
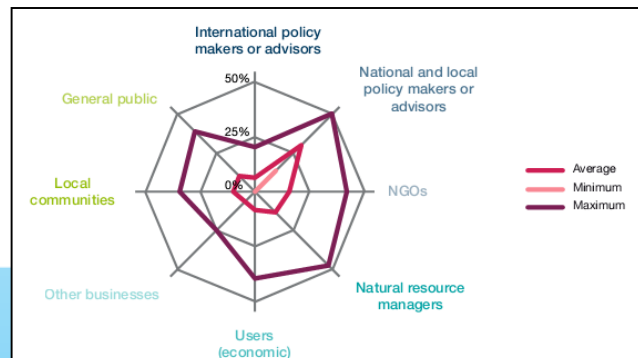
